Bachelor's Degrees

Heritage offers several bachelor's degree programs that prepare you to become a certified teacher. Whether your goal is to teach in an elementary school or to become a specialized instructor in math, art, science, English language arts, or humanities in a middle or high school, Heritage has programs that will get you to where you want to be.

One Goal—Two Pathways

Earn your degree in the way that best fits your goals, learning style, and life situation.

HU Theory to Practice

This path allows you to participate in engaging, interactive classes, many of which are conveniently scheduled during evenings and weekends.

In addition, you will participate in field work to prepare you for your co-teaching experience in a K-12 classroom during your final semester.

HU Residency

Become a teacher by working side by side with peers and an experienced classroom instructor in a K-8 classroom four days a week. Spend the fifth day on campus with your teammates in a day of seminars that teach you content knowledge as well as the theory and practice of teaching. You will graduate with a bachelor's degree and be qualified for Elementary Education and ELL endorsements. An additional Special Education endorsement is available as well.

Master's Degrees

Leverage your existing bachelor's degree and become a teacher in as little as one year. Earn a Master in Teaching (MIT) degree from Heritage University. In addition, you can earn your degree in a way that best fits your learning style and life situation through either HU Theory To Practice, HU Residency or our intensive HU Accelerate program.

One Goal–Three Pathways

HU Theory to Practice

This path allows you to participate in engaging, interactive classes that are held on Friday evenings and during the day on Saturdays. During your final semester you will apply what you've learned during your field experience in a K-8 classroom.

HU Residency

Learn the art and science of teaching by teaching. You will spend four days a week working in a K-8 classroom with an education team comprised of your peers and an experienced teacher. Then on the fifth day, you will attend seminars on content knowledge and education theory and practice on the Heritage campus. Not only will you earn your master's degree, but you will graduate with nearly two years of teaching experience. You can earn your master's degree with a K-8 endorsement and be qualified for an ELL or Special Education endorsement.

HU Accelerate

Earn a Master in Teaching degree in just one year while teaching full-time. In addition to the K-8 endorsement, candidates graduate prepared to certify with an English Language Learner, Bilingual Education or Special Education endorsement.
